COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT



We are pleased to announce that <u>The Missing Entrepreneurs 2023</u> <u>report</u> was launched on 30 November 2023 with the participation of the **OECD Deputy Secretary-General Yoshiki Takeuchi** and the **European Commission Director-General Joost Korte**. The report is the seventh edition in a series of biennial reports.

The report finds that if youth (18-29 years old) participated in early-stage entrepreneurship at the same rate as "core age" men (30-49 years old), there would be an additional 3.6 million "missing youth entrepreneurs" in OECD countries. **David Halabisky** wrote an article about unlocking the potential of young entrepreneurs for economic growth in the Guardian.
